Conditions of Entry

Accommodation at the College is available to country students irrespective of disability, religious or cultural background but is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Intending Boarders need to be accepted into a specialised course at a Government high school or a non residential College in the metropolitan area. Refer below for details.

or

- (2) Not have a high school in their town, or must travel more than 1 hour to a high school by bus.
- (3) Their education is adversely affected by extreme travel distance.

Applecross High:	Tennis, Academic Extension (Talented& Gifted), Visual Arts.
Como Secondary College:	Hockey, Golf, Music, Media & Drama, Travel & Tourism, Science & Technology. Academic Extension (Talented & Gifted).
Forrestfield High:	Cricket, Netball, Soccer, Swimming, Australian Rules Football, Rugby
Melville High:	Aeronautics, Hearing impaired & education support, Intensive language, Academic extension (Talented & Gifted).
Mt Lawley High:	Indonesian, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Greek & Music.
John Curtin College of the Arts:	Drama, Dance, Ballet, music, Arts Media, Soccer, Nautical Studies, Academic excellence-Maths & Science.
Willetton:	Basketball, Computing, Academic Extension (Talented & Gifted), Arts & Crafts.
