Accommodation Fee:

Our boarding service includes accommodation, meals, and some recreation and activity costs. The full cost to parents of our boarding service is **\$19,000.00** per student. This amount applies to our years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 students. Year 12 boarding fees for the year will be **\$16,625.00** as a majority do not return in term 4 or only attend for a few weeks.

Application Fee

On new application's, a non-refundable fee of **\$150** is payable. This is not applicable to returning students.

Payment Schedule for students entitled to AIC and BAHA Government subsidies (**Gap Fee**)

1 st scheduled Gap Fee payment for term 1 2025	1 st December 2024	\$ 2,250.00
2 nd scheduled Gap Fee payment for term 2 2025	1 st April 2025	\$ 2,250.00
3 rd scheduled Gap Fee payment for term 3 2025	1 st July 2025	\$ 2,250.00
3 rd scheduled Gap Fee payment for year 12 students only	1 st July 2025	\$3,375.00
4 th scheduled Gap Fee payment for term 4 2025 year 7, 8, 9, 10, 11's only	1 st October 2025	\$ 2,250.00

The Gap Fee is the boarding fee payable by parents/guardians that Government subsidies don't cover.

**This figure is only a suggested range within which the amount payable will fall. The Gap Fee will be finalised in December this year once Government departments release their subsidy calculations. Regardless the total Gap fee will be due on October 1st. Due to Government department means test processes, please be aware that when all Government payments have reached us by December each year there may be a shortfall or overpayment that needs to be settled between parents/guardians and Rotary Residential College.*



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Management reserves the right to: (a) decline to accept a student to commence a new term; (b) expel a student at any time if fees are not received by the due or agreed date. Parents/Guardians will be liable for interest, fees, and legal costs involved in the collection of outstanding fees.

Accommodation fees cover a student whilst attending full time schooling and exams. Outside these times the boarding student becomes the Parents/Guardians responsibility.

Notice of Withdrawal:

- **If a student is to be withdrawn from Rotary Residential College one (1) full boarding terms notice in writing is required.** The accommodation fees for the current term and the following term will be charged.
- A "Notice of Withdrawal" whereby a student will cease boarding at the end of term 3 will not be accepted and the full year's fee is payable.
- In the event of the withdrawal of a student instigated by Rotary Residential College management during the school year, the accommodation fees for the current and the following term will be charged.

Note: Depending on the timing of the student withdrawal, it is possible for a debt to arise with Centrelink and with the College. Although Centrelink funds are paid to the College the parent/guardian are legally responsible for the claims and any debts that can arise with Centrelink.
